Beginning Sewing - Pillowcase

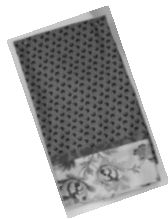

My Label Review-Pants

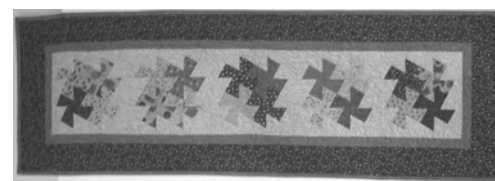
